Project: Celebrate Gymnastics Club Type: Destination Park Conversion

Cost: £200,000

Club history

Celebrate Gymnastics Club formed in 2020 with an ambition to develop a club straight into a dedicated facility. Based in Essex, the club set out to identify a suitable building to convert, the cost of which in the area is often prohibitive. After considering various options the club forged a relationship with Barleylands Farm Park and Village in Billericay. The potential opportunities for both parties based on footfall were numerous. Barleylands submitted a Change of Use application for a 7,600 sq. ft. barn which was granted in January 2021.

The project

The barn needed minor repairs to the roof which were the responsibility of the landlord. Internally an additional toilet block to complement the shared facilities on site was required and the construction of a viewing area and office. A full equipment kit out by Continental Sports was also installed. The conversion took just 4 weeks, just in time for a bank holiday opening in June 2021.

The investment

Total project costs - £200,000 Club Capital Investment - £100,000 Other Funds/Investment - £100,000 Loan Term – 4 years at 4% interest, with a 1-year capital repayment holiday
